District Cricket

District Cricket is part of the Northamptonshire Boys Player Pathway and sits between Club and County. The County is split into three District areas and the age groups are under 11, 13 and 15.

Players are nominated by their Clubs and a ten-week indoor winter programme gives the players coaching and at the end around 15 players are selected to make up the summer squad. They then play around eight games of different format cricket including T20 and One Day Cricket.
